

# RESEARCH PROJECT LOG BOOK FOR THE SCHOOL OF BUSINESS

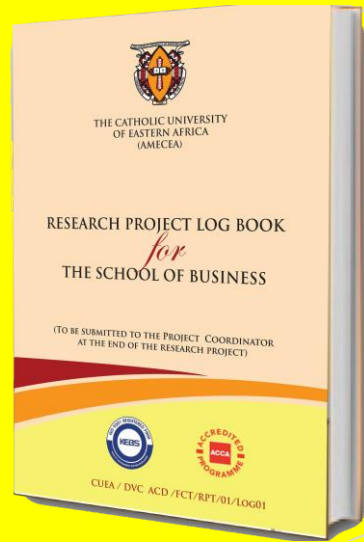
