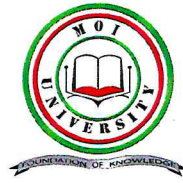

REQUIREMENTS FOR ABSTRACTS & PAPERS

Abstract: Between 200 and 300 words, Times New Romans, 12-point font; should be one exhaustive single-spaced paragraph containing the basic introduction of the main issue, a clear problem statement, methodology and theory, the main arguments or findings, main conclusion and way forward or recommendations.

Paper: Times New Romans, 12-point font, single spaced. Use clear titles and subtitles. Use footnotes for References and other clarifications. Indicate **PAGE NUMBERS FOR ALL REFERENCES** in the footnotes. There should be a list of References at the end of your article. References are formatted according to the MLA style.

PLEASE NOTE: The **ROLE** and **PERSPECTIVE** of the **CHURCH** must be **CLEARLY SHOWN** in each of the issues addressed in your article(s), in line with the mission statement of AMECEA Gaba Publications, namely to evangelize through the print media. Abstracts and papers that **WILL NOT** exhibit these requirements **SHALL NOT** be accepted. **Well-written articles will be published in the AFER journal, vol. 61, nos. 1-4 of 2019.**

SUBMISSION: The deadline for submission of **abstracts** is **June 30th, 2018**. **Full papers** should be submitted on or before **August 31st, 2018**. Send the **WORD Doc copy** of your abstract and paper to: conferencegaba@cuea.edu, copied to jnyenyembe@cuea.edu

REGISTRATION GUIDELINES

- (i) The **Conference Fee** shall be **Ksh. 4,500** (or **USD 150** for those from outside Kenya) per writer. This fee is inclusive of registration, costs of conference materials, meals and branded bags. The fee, however, **DOES NOT** include **ACCOMMODATION**. Notify us early in case you need accommodation arrangements.
- (ii) **Payment Rules:** Pay 50% of the fee upon submission of abstracts and the remaining balance on submission of full paper. Late payments are highly discouraged. Note that there is **NO REFUND** for failing to participate in the Conference after payment.
