Minimum Qualifications

- Must have supervised at least four master's theses;
- Must have at least three (3) years teaching experience at university level;
- Should have evidence of administration experience;
- Should be proficient in computer packages.

- Must be a person of integrity; morally upright and mature;
- Must be able to work under minimum supervision;
- He/she should be flexible and adaptable enough to work in a multicultural environment;
