## APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Attach copies of Academic Certificates/Transcripts and together with a non-refundable, non-creditable application fee of Kshs. 1000 for Certificates, Diploma and Kshs. 2,000 for undergraduate, graduate and post-graduate programmes .
