ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Post-graduate Diploma programmes

- Minimum of a Bachelor's Degree in any field except PGD in Teaching in Higher Education which requires a minimum of Master's Degree

Masters programmes

- A Bachelor's degree with second class honors upper division
- A Bachelor's degree with second class honors - lower division and two years working experience.
- A Bachelor's degree with second class honors - lower division with a postgraduate diploma in a related field.

Doctoral programmes

- A Master degree in a relevant field.
