5.0 PRINCIPAL RESPONSIBILITY

HOD and AEC has the overall responsibility of ensuring that this procedure remains adequate for recruiting members to the association and ensure it is effectively applied.

6.0 PROCEDURE DETAILS

Recruiting Alumni members

- 6.1 The HOD shall prepare Alumni membership and Annual Fund forms at the end of every year (see Appendix A) and avail them to the prospects.
- 6.2 The HOD/AEC shall invite prospects to join the CUEA Alumni Association via one on one conversation, emails, and posters on notice boards throughout the year.
- 6.3 The HOD/AEC shall avail the membership and Annual Fund recruitment forms upon request for the prospect to fill in and join.
- 6.4 The HOD/AEC shall receive the filled in forms and membership and Annual Fund dues and issue official CUEA receipt immediately.
- 6.5 Get the Membership registration form after the invitation of the prospect to the Association.
- 6.6 The ADC shall clean up the data by verifying details immediately they are handed in.
- 6.7 The ADC shall input the data at the earliest opportunity into a computer system.

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
- 6.8 The ADC shall present the Data to the HOD for verification immediately he is done with inputting.
- 6.9 HOD shall verify the data against the graduates list and forward any correction to the ADC immediately he goes through it.
- 6.10 In case there are corrections, the ADC shall make corrections on the data soonest.
- 6.11 The ADC shall file the hard copies immediately after corrections.
- 6.12 The HOD/AEC shall remind, motivate and update the prospects duly seasonally or annually.

Statement of Need for CUEA Annual Fund

The scenario at CUEA and many universities in developing world rely heavily on tuition. However, the tuition base at CUEA has drastically decreased as a result of competition from new cheap universities with less expensive current expenditure, public government aided universities offering regular degree to the would be privately sponsored students at low costs and public universities who enjoy direct finance support from the government or development partners establishing campuses all over the country. The young private universities enjoy the benefit of limited courses on offer and cheap labour of young lecturers as well as part time staff. Older private universities like CUEA find themselves unable to lower their fees against the background of growing demand for higher education. Thus students from financially unstable backgrounds who desire to have a CUEA degree miss the opportunity especially when the university is not able to offer scholarship or subsidize fees. In addition, the inflation rates in the country and global economic crunch has made it hard to the would be students to join university. Thus the income base for your university is threatened and for CUEA to continue providing education in such financially hostile environment must therefore raise additional funds each year to bridge this shortfall. The Annual Fund is critical to the CUEA and its ability to provide students and faculty with the resources necessary for success in the pursuit of academic excellence.

Tuition paid by our 4,000 student's covers less than what the university needs to service the loan borrowed to put up the state of art learning resource centre and current expenditure cost of education. The gap is meant to be closed by gifts to the Annual Fund. The Annual Fund is even more critical when international donors – are less than in recent years.

Annual Fund gifts to CUEA are the most flexible money we raise, because they can be used where the University's needs are greatest. The greatest needs right now are for scholarship, learning resource centre and faculty support, and support for ensuring that the CUEA community accurately reflects its regional nature.
